The details are as follows:

Date: Wednesday 14th June

Time: 8.00am start

Format: Breakfast (provided at no charge), guest speakers and musical performance punctuated by social interaction starters.

All boys are to assemble the main NBHS quad at 7.30am at which time buses will transport half of our boys to Napier Girls' High School.

To assist with early morning transportation a free Nimons bus will leave:

- Taradale Lee Road Bus stop at 7.10am and Durham Drive Tamatea (just past Z Service Station) at 7.20am
- Bay View at 7.00 am and the Marineland Motel (Westshore) at 7.10 am
- Those who live near NGHS and are on the list for NGHS may travel directly there (by 7.45 am) and return with the other NBHS students (who are guests at NGHS) to NBHS at the end of the breakfast.
