Day Students Tutor/Whanau Goal Setting Conferences will run on **Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> and Friday 14<sup>th</sup> March**. This involves a three-way conference with the **tutor teacher, student, and parent/caregiver**. Normal school will not operate on these days.

**All students are expected to attend with a parent/caregiver**. Each conference is allocated a **20-minute time slot**.

**Year 9 students:** the focus is on how their year has started and to address any questions.

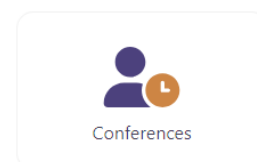
**Year 10 – 13 students:** the focus is goal setting. Boys thrive on having targets and goals to work toward. We see this process as a vital part in your son achieving all he can in 2025. The meeting will focus on what they achieved in 2024, goals for 2025 and the steps they need to take to successfully achieve these goals.

**Booking these conferences** is to be done through your **SchoolBridge** app or login via your web browser. On the dashboard will see a button called "Conferences".



Click on this button and you will be able to select the appropriate conference either Day Student or Hostel for your son. Select from the available time slot a meeting time. You can provide a brief message for the tutor teacher if needed.

**Not logged on to SchoolBridge before?**

For those that have not logged into SchoolBridge previously please see below for details on how this can be done.

This is our main method of communication to our school community. You will need to download the app to your phone and/or use the web-based version.

**Sign In:** if you have a Google, Microsoft or Facebook account and use the same email account as you have registered with Napier Boys' you can use this to sign in. For parents without this you can sign in use the Magic Link (see below)

**Magic Link Sign In**

1. Click on the link below.
2. Select the Email Magic Link sign-in and enter the email you have registered as your contact email with us.
3. You will receive an email to that address that will contain both a link to sign in or a code that can be entered to sign in. The code needs to be used within 72 hours of receiving it.
4. Once signed in on the app you won't need to sign in again.
5. If using the web-based version if you sign out you will need to resend the Magic Link to re-sign in.

You will also be able to use the "Sibling Switcher" to quickly and easily switch being students, without additional passwords being needed. You can also add students at different schools who also use SchoolBridge.
