

Kia ora koutou

Scinde House Tutor/Whanau Goal Setting Conferences will run on **Wednesday 12th, Thursday 13th and Friday 14th March**. This involves a three-way conference with the **tutor teacher, student, and parent/caregiver**. Normal school will not operate on the Thursday and Friday.

The conferences will be available **in person** on **WEDNESDAY 12th March** and online via MS Teams video call on Thursday 13th and Friday 14th March, for hostel families.

All students are **expected to attend** with a **parent/caregiver**. Each conference is allocated a **15-minute time slot**.

Year 9 students: The focus of the conference is on how their year has started and to address any questions. Year 9 boarders will attend regular classes on Wednesday. Students whose parents attend the Wednesday afternoon conferences will be free to leave with their family after their conference. Other Year 9 boarders will return to the hostel as per normal.

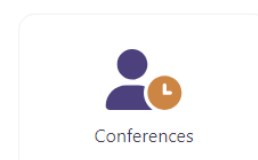
Year 10 – 13 students: The focus of the conferences is goal setting. Boys thrive on having targets and goals to work toward. We see this process as a vital part in your son achieving all he can in 2025. The conference will focus on what they achieved in 2024, goals for 2025 and the steps they need to take to successfully achieve these goals. Students will be in regular classes on Wednesday. Students whose parents/caregivers attend will be free to leave with their family after their conference. Other Year 10 – 13 boarders will return to the Hostel as per normal.

Video Conference Meetings: Thursday 13th March: 10:00am - 12:20pm and 1:00 – 3:00pm
Friday 15th March: 10:00am - 12:00pm and 12:40 – 2:40pm

Booking these conferences is to be done through your **SchoolBridge** app or login via your web browser. On the dashboard will see a button called "Conferences".



Click on this button and you will be able to select the appropriate conference either Day or Hostel for your son. Select your sons' tutor teachers and available time slots will come up and you can click on the times to book.

Not logged on to SchoolBridge before?

For those that have not logged into SchoolBridge previously please see below for details on how this can be done.

This is our main method of communication to our school community. You will need to download the app to their phone and/or use the web-based version.

Sign In: if you have a Google, Microsoft or Facebook account and use the same email account as you have registered with Napier Boys' you can use this to sign in. For parents without this you can sign in use the Magic Link (see below)

Magic Link Sign In

1. Click on the link below.
2. Select the Email Magic Link sign-in and enter the email you have registered as your contact email with us.
3. You will receive an email to that address that will contain both a link to sign in or a code that can be entered to sign in. The code needs to be used within 72 hours of receiving it.
4. Once signed in on the app you won't need to sign in again.
5. If using the web-based version if you sign out you will need to resend the Magic Link to re-sign in.

You will also be able to use the "Sibling Switcher" to quickly and easily switch being students, without additional passwords being needed. You can also add students at different schools who also use SchoolBridge.
